New inspection lab

In the current year, we have mainly made investments in the areas of measurement and inspection. For example, we have obtained new Nikon measuring microscopes (with camera system) and new inspection software. The inspection lab has been enlarged and equipped with a ventilation system.

CNC-machines

As mentioned in the introduction, we are planning several investments for 2011. By procuring two new CNC machines, we would be adding to our train of machines.
